VINTAGE SUMMARY

2020 was a hot dry vintage in McLaren Vale. Strong winds during spring resulted in consistently poor flowering and fruit set. As such, yields were low. Vintage started and finished in a heart beat but fruit quality and flavour intensity was exceptional.

WINEMAKING

We distilled a portion of the White Frontignac base wine at McLaren Vale Distillery and used the spirit to steep the botanicals in. wormwood, aniseed myrtle, finger lime and orange peel were used.

We then added the spirit to the base wine and allowed to infuse for 6 months before hand bottling by Team Ramble.
